Abstract submissions must include:

1. Presentation Title

An engaging title targeted toward all audiences

2. Presenter Information:

- a. Presenter name (first and last)
- b. Email address
- c. Organization, institution, affiliation, or business
- d. State, Country

3. Abstract Text

400 word maximum. Describes your research, product, idea, etc.

4. Abstract Summary

2-3 sentences that summarize your presentation, for print in conference materials if selected.

Format:

- 1 page maximum
- 12-point font
- Figures, tables, hyperlinks accepted
- PDF documents preferred
