# INTENT

solicit proposals from state Sea Grant programs seeking to adapt Maine's template for application in their own state.

# ELIGIBILITY

- Only Sea Grant programs as fiscal agent
- Option for subcontracts
- Developed or new program area

# Technical Specifications

- Built in standards-compliant XHTML
- No back-end database
- Can be installed on almost any modern web server
- Conforms to XHTML 1.1, CSS 2.1 and Section 508 accessibility standards
- Maintenance requires familiarity with XHTML and CSS

# FUNDING CRITERIA

- three to four proposals, ~ \$3000 - \$4000
- \$1 non-federal match to \$2 federal request required (50% match)

# 2 PAGE NARRATIVE

- Alignment with program goals, stakeholder needs
- Anticipated changes to model
- Approach used to adapt site
- Program, state resources available
- Resources sought
- Anticipated outcomes

# EVALUATION

- Relationship to state SG program goals: 25%
- Relationship to stakeholder needs, LOS: 25%
- Sound approach and budget: 25%
- Anticipated results: 20%
- Investigator qualifications: 5%
