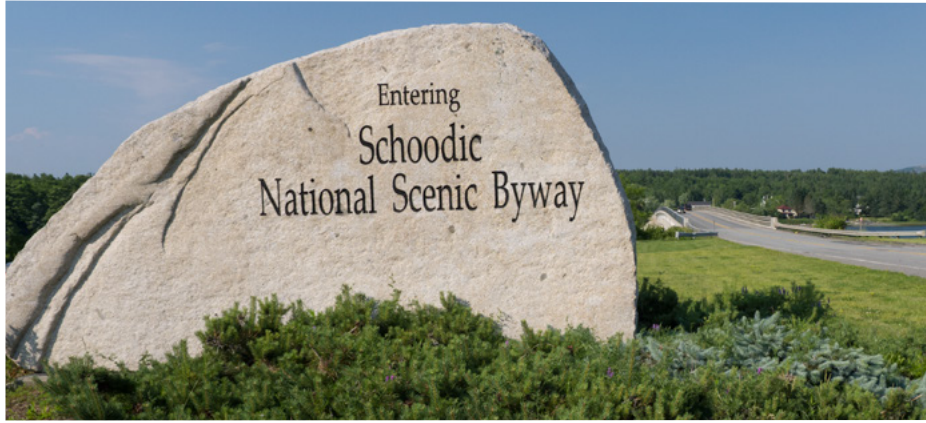

Please join us on May 9, 2017, at the Schoodic Institute for a Downeast Fisheries Trail Celebration and Field Trip!

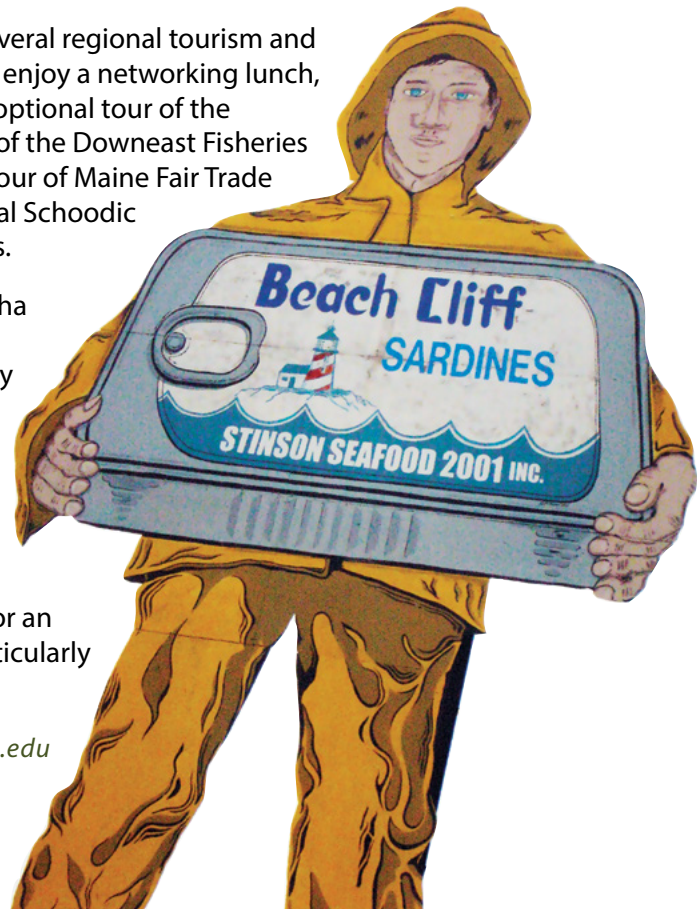
The Downeast Fisheries Trail is celebrating FIVE successful years of helping to connect residents and visitors with our rich fisheries heritage and culture.
