 - b. MSG and ISSC will develop a scope of work in consultation with interested parties
- 2. A 3-member scoring committee will be established to review the proposals and to select the vendor to conduct the review
 - a. Maine Sea Grant (Paul Anderson)
 - b. DMR (David Etnier or Linda Mercer)
 - c. Shellfish harvesting industry (Valy Steverlynck)
- 3. Special Fund for Peer Review of the DMR Public Health Division
 - a. Public and private funds
 - b. Grants distributed at the direction of the scoring committee to conduct the review
 - c. Nonlapsing
 - d. SPO \$5000; DMR \$5000; Industry ~ \$25,000
 - e. Report to legislature on status of fund on January 15, 2009
- 4. Maine Sea Grant will provide a report on the review
 - a. In conjunction with the vendor
 - b. Findings and recommendations on legislation
 - c. To MRC by January 15, 2008
 - d. MRC may submit a bill to the 123rd legislature
- 5. DMR will determine the need and feasibility of a shellfish advisory council
 - a. With input from the scoring committee members and others from the shellfish harvesting industry
 - b. Purpose of this advisory committee would be to improve communication between the department and the industry and to provide advice to the department and the MRC.
 - c. DMR will report on these findings to the MRC by January 15, 2008
