Maine's Working Waterfront Coalition Governance Structure

Executive Committee

- The Executive Committee is an internal distinction within the WWC (all members of the Executive Committee are also members of the Steering Committee)
- Made up of a small group of individuals to set meeting agendas, record and distribute meeting minutes, and communicate with the Steering Committee.
- Serve as spokespeople for public relations
- Set membership guidelines.

*It is the intention of the smaller Executive Committee to help facilitate the activities of the larger Steering Committee and to keep the governance structure of the WWC simple.

Current Executive Committee Composition: 2 state agencies (Jim Connors-Maine State Planning Office & Cindy Smith-Maine Department of Marine Resources), 1 community development organization (Hugh Cowperthwaite-Coastal Enterprises, Inc.), 1 coastal & island community non-profit (Rob Snyder/Jen Litteral-the Island Institute) David Jermann-Islands Coalition, 1 marine trade organization (Susan Swanton-Maine Marine Trade Association) 1 commercial fish organization (Patrice McCarron-Maine Lobstermen's Association), 1 aquaculture organization (Sebastian Belle-Maine Aquaculture Association) & Joey Donnelly-York Harbor Board.

Steering Committee

- Set priorities and Committee work.
- Decision making and policy positions
- Discuss issues, updates, projects, committee work
- Communicate the WWC activities with their membership (others within their organization).
- Expectation to participate in meetings (attend 50% of the annual meetings or step down)
- Contribute money and/or in kind to the effort.

The Steering Committee is currently made up of: State agencies, Industry Associations, Industry people (fishermen, aquaculturists), small business owners, Community Development Organizations, Municipalities, Land Trusts, Environmental Groups, Education and outreach groups.

Meetings

Meetings will be held as needed rather than a regular schedule. In general we try to meet from 10:00 to 12:00 at a mid-coast location between Portland and Belfast and inland to Augusta. These will be announced through the Coalition email distribution list.
